FREE FOOD AND SUPPLIES DELIVERED TO IMPOVERISHED INMATE FAMILIES ON SATURDAY, MAY 2, 2020 AT 2:30pm

Houston, Texas... On Saturday, May 2, at 2:30pm Bishop James Dixon, II. Harris County Sheriff Ed Gonzalez will join a caravan of volunteers to distribute Food collected from The Inmate Family Adoption Project Food Drive. Inmate families suffer from limited resources. In the wake of Covid 19, the loss of food and supplies is a tragic existence. Presently, there are nearly 8,000 inmates in the Harris County Jail, most of whom are awaiting trial. As most inmates are head of households, their family members are in dire need of assistance.

Who: Bishop James Dixon, II and Harris County Sheriff Ed Gonzalez

What: "The Inmate Family Adoption Project's" Food Distribution Day. Bishop James Dixon II, Sheriff Ed Gonzalez and local pastors will deliver much needed food and supplies to inmate families across Houston/Harris County

When: Saturday, May 2, 2020 starting at 2:30 immediately after the Food Drive.

How: Food and supplies are collected from donors from the food drive, then transferred to distribution vehicles. Hundreds of volunteers along with Bishop James Dixon and Harris County Sheriff Ed Gonzalez will distribute the food and supplies to impoverished inmate families across Houston/Harris County. Most of the resources collected are generous donations from the congregations of participating pastors, other Houston/Harris County sponsors, including Percy Cruzot of Frenchy's Restaurant.
