HOUSTON'S FAITH LEADERS, LAW ENFORCEMENT AND ELECTED OFFICIALS HOLD "A CALL FOR JUSTICE AND PEACEFUL PROTEST" PRESS CONFERENCE TODAY, MAY 30TH AT 4PM

WHAT: A press conference with Faith Leaders, Law Enforcement and Elected Officials discussing a "Call for Justice and Peaceful Protest".

WHY: Amid the last days of chaotic and destructive protest, local pastor, and social activist Bishop James Dixon II organizes Faith, Law Enforcement and Elected officials to speak to the Houston community and communities across the nation in a press conference today at 4pm.

Bishop Dixon says, "He understands the frustration and degradation of this abomination of justice. He also mentions "despite the arrest of MPD officer Derek Chauvin, the nation is still reeling over the death of Floyd George and now the insult of merely charging Chauvin with 3rd degree homicide when Mr. Floyd was essentially tortured and murdered in the street".

Faith Leaders, Law Enforcement and Elected Officials will discuss the ongoing issues and provide direction on how to successfully call for justice through peaceful protest.
